In one-to-one tutorials and through conceptual guidance with the internationally acclaimed fashion designers at the helm of the Department, students generate ideas, develop concepts and create and present individual. innovative and visionary womenswear, menswear or non-binary fashion. The main course, the so-called central artistic subject, focuses on developing a holistic design vision by exploring traditional European fashion knowledge in dialogue with a global cultural heritage and an awareness of sustainable design choices.

Graduates either found their own fashion labels or launch careers at existing national and international labels and/or fashion houses.

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To study at the Fashion Department, interested applicants need to pass an ENTRANCE EXAM. The next possible entrance exam will take place in February 2023 and will be held in 2 PHASES.

Part of PHASE 1 is to submit an APPLICATION.

Applicants who successfully complete
PHASE 1 participate in PHASE 2, which
consists of creative tasks and an interview.

Applicants who successfully pass also
PHASE 2 can begin to study in winter term
2023/24, starting October 2023.
